On 12/30/09 at about 5:45 pm a complainant reported that their 11 year-old daughter was injured when a group of unidentified boys who were shooting pellet guns shot her in the face and arms. The victim was treated at a local hospital for her injuries. The boys were described as being Caucasian between the ages of 12 to 15 who were wearing white T shirts and dark color shorts. The incident occurred at the Desert Mountain Park and investigation is continuing.

On 12/31/09 at about 1:50 am Deputies arrested and booked into the 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Jail a 21 year-old man for Extreme DUI and an outstanding Warrant of Arrest incidental to a traffic stop in the vicinity of Ellsworth and Germann Roads. The vehicle was impounded indefinitely.

Deputies investigated a total of **47** collisions this period.
